

What have we been up to? Life Coaching with Carrie Vee


Working with the clients at Mom's House has been an incredible experience and blessing beyond words.

Speech and Language Evaluations

This semester we partnered again to provide all of our children with free speech and language evaluations. Clinicians and students conducted observations and assessments with the results provided to parents and teachers. Parents are offered the opportunity to meet with the clinicians if there are any concerns reported. Clinicians also provide the teachers with feedback and strategies to improve speech and language development. As part our ongoing collaboration, Teaching staff also participated in professional development training with clinicians to improve our speech and language instruction.

I have taught adult GED and ESL classes, College courses, 7-12 English and have been an administrator k12. It has been an amazing 30+ years, and I know for a fact that without Mom's House I would not be where I am today. Matthew graduated HS on the honor roll, went on to get his bachelor's degree at Binghamton University graduating with honors and went to Upstate Medical School in Syracuse. He then did his residency on Long Island at Northwell Hospital and is now a trauma radiologist in Atlanta Georgia. During his residency Matthew met the love of his life and they now have two children ages 3 & 4. I went on to Marry the brother of one of the other mothers at Mom's House and then proceeded to have 4 more children and a total of three grandchildren. We live an incredibly blessed and full life.
